



Draft of a Tract of Land situated in Salem Township formerly Springfield Township in the County of Westmoreland containing one hundred seventy one acres and fifty four perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. surveyed by George Keechling the 22<sup>d</sup> of January 1842, then Surveyor for the Heirs of George Storn deceased being a part of a larger Tract of 265 acres and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Clymer dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1776, and surveyed 16<sup>d</sup> Nov. 1776 by Geo Woods D.S.
