


*The line of District No 6 James Potter Esq. D.J.*



The Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the waters of Stamp Creek or Punkoutanee near the 23<sup>o</sup> mile tree. North of the West Branch of Susquehanna in the line of District No 6, in the County of Northumberland containing 202 acres and allowance of six acres per Clerk surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785, for <sup>John Hart</sup> David Kennedy Esq. in pursuance of a Warrant No 645, bearing date the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1785.
