Surveyed the above described tract of land in pursuance
of a Warrant granted to Peter Best dated 1st March 1839 & situated on a
branch of the foot mile run on the Great Ridge, in Donegal Town-
ship County of Westmoreland, containing One hundred two acres,
one hundred twelve perches & two roods & 1/2.

Note - I believe the above described land to be part of a tract surveyed on
11th April 1786, on Warrant in the name of James Johnston, dated 11th June 1785.
There has been a resident settlement on the tract continued from May 1814, until
now. The improvements are about twentyfive or thirty acres cleared, and a round
log cabin and stable thereon erected. I believe grain has been raised
on the tract every year since A.D. 1814
