



Situation on the East Side of Monongahela River taking it on its general direction, and was surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> August 1784, in pursuance of a Warrant dated 5<sup>th</sup> July 1784, but was found to be incorrect, and as well to interfere with the lands of Jonathan Arnold, deceased, which had been consentably designated, in order to correct the errors of the former survey, and as well to avoid interference, on the 25<sup>th</sup> of ... Aided by the draught of Arnold (which I had not before) I have adjusted what was lacking of the former survey "viz" corrected the error, and conformed the present to the lines of Arnold, before mentioned - impursuing the former lines, adhering to the lines of Arnold when interfere with, and including a very small Triangle of A. for sake of regularity. I find 1 1/2<sup>at</sup> Vallowand contains 6 1/2<sup>of</sup> of a surplus beyond instructions the owner pleads his having peaceably enjoyed it for as long a time, and alleges that on statement of circumstances patent will be granted including the excess, At his request and Risk I offer it, subject to your pleasure in accepting or obliterating obliterating 29<sup>th</sup> June 1805.
