



The Draught of a Tract of Land called \_\_\_\_\_ situated in Buffalo Valley, Berks County, containing Two hundred forty seven acres and an half acre with the usual allowance of six acres of land for Roads, Being the allotment which fell to the share of Ensign William Piper according to the agreement made among the Officers of Col. Francis's Corps. In the Division of a Tract of Eight Thousand acres, granted to and Survey'd for them in Buffalo Valley aforesaid on the 1<sup>o</sup>, 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> days of March Anno Domini, 1769.
