



The Draught of a Tract of Land, called ^{Pennsylvania} ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ situated in Buffalo Valley in the County of Berks, containing Six hundred Twenty two acres with the usual allowance of six acres per cent for Roads. Being the allotment which fell to the share of Capt. James Irwin according to the agreement made among the Officers of Col. Francis' Corps. In their Division of a tract of Eight Thousand Acres, granted and Survey'd to them in Buffalo Valley aforesaid, on the 1st, 2^d and 3^d days of March Anno Domini 1769. In pursuance of Order N^o 1.
