



The Draught of a Tract of Land called "The Conestoga", situated on the West side of the River Susquehanna adjoining the line or bounds of the Purchase in 1754. In the County of Berks, containing one Thousand Three Hundred Twenty eight acres with the usual allowance of six acres p. Cent. for Roads. Survey'd the 18th day of February Anno Dom. 1769. for the Honble the Proprietaries of the Province of Pennsylvania. In pursuance of a Warrant under the seal of the Land Office bearing date at Philad^a the 27th day of Dec-ember Anno Dom. 1768.
