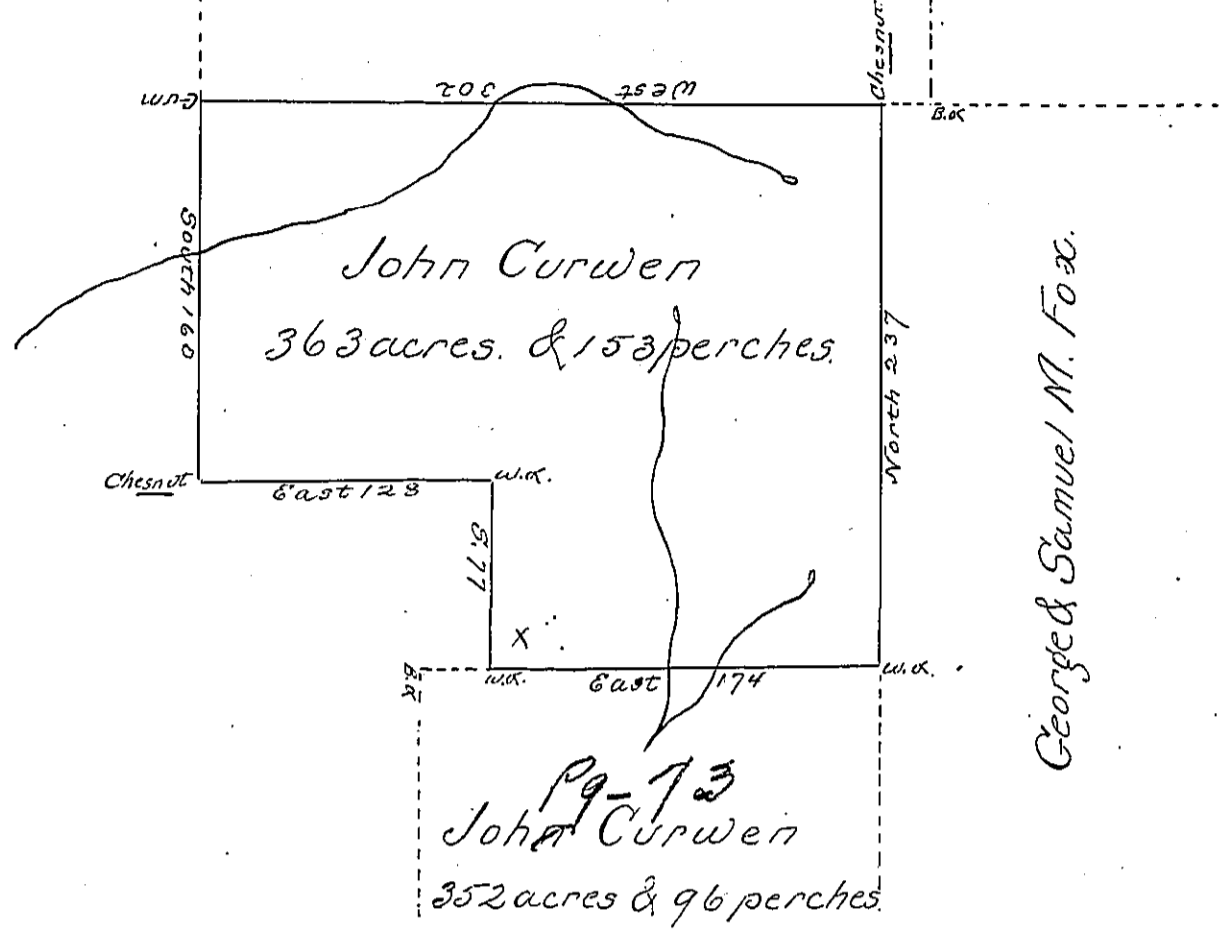


Trustees of Dickinson College George & Saml. Fox.



Surveyd the 27th day of September 1786 for John Curwen the the above described Tract of land containing three Hundred & sixty three acres and one hundred and fifty three perches with the usual allowance of Six p^l & p^r. Situated and lying about three miles East of Allegheny River and about five miles North of the Mouth of Tobys Creek adjoining Lands of George and Samuel Michael Fox and land Surveyd for the Trustees of Dickinson College in pursuance of a Warrant granted him the 17th day of May 1785 No 445 late purchase Northumberland County
