



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19th day of April 1774 I did on the 11th day of March 1775 Survey and lay out for George Ingels a certain Lot of Ground at the North End of the City of Philada. & without the limits thereof marked in a General Plan of the Lots there Number Twenty three containing in Breadth North and South on the East side of New Market Street Twenty feet, and in length East and West One hundred and Twenty feet, Bounded Westward by New Market ^{street} aforesaid, Northward by Lot Number Twenty Two, Eastward by Lot Number Three, and Southward by Lot Number Twenty four. Returned into the Secretarys office the 23d day of March 1775.
