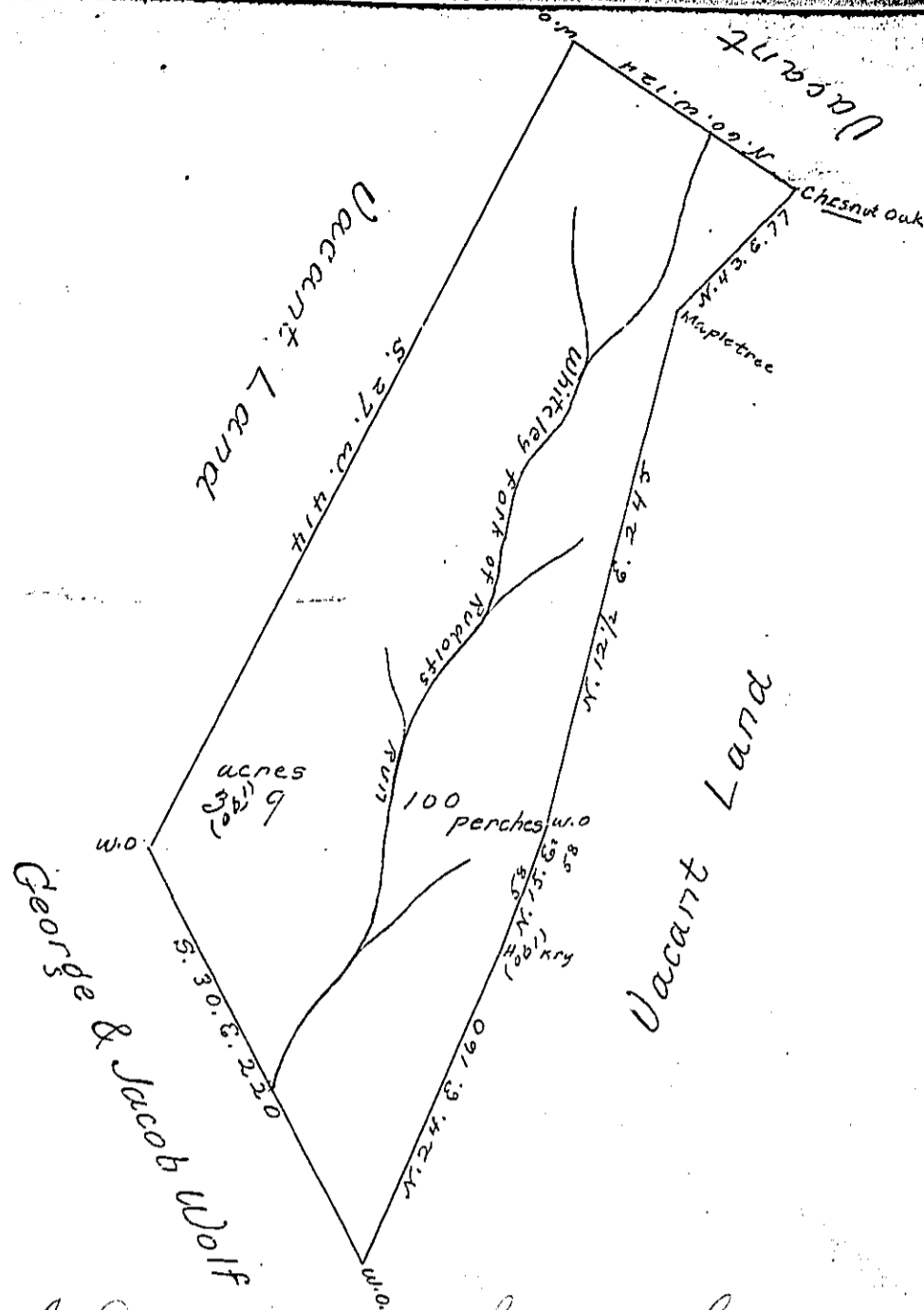

A Draught of a Survey Situate on the waters of Dunkard Creek called Randolph in Washington County, and Greentownship Surveyed November 5th Day 1790 Containing three hundred and ninety nine acres and 100 perches and allowance of Six percent for Roads &c. in pursuance of a warrant granted John Knaighn 23th of December 1784

Note - the aforesaid warrant was originally Jno. Hoge S. executed on another tract of Land and the return thereof made to the S. Gs office but was afterwards found to interfer with price surveys I therefore (on the request of the owners) made and returned the above Survey.
