



The above is a Draught of a tract of Land situate on the waters of Buffelw Creek Cald. sugar tree containing one hundred and ninety one acres and a half acre with allowance of six pents surveyed January the 16th 1787 in pursuance of the hereto annexed Certificate granted to Thos. Clarke.

We the Commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Yohogania Monongalia and Ohio do hereby certify that Thos. Clarke is entitled to Four Hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the waters Buffelw Creek to include his settlement made in the year 1774 also a right in preemption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Cops Fort the 25th day of January 1788 the fourth year of the Commonwealth
