

Begins at a Hickory in a line of Robert Jeffries's land thence west by vacant land 204 pches to a post thence by Vacant Land & the Land of Robt. Way South 500 pches to a post thence East by Vacant land 204 pches to a post thence North by the Land of Charles Jones Vacant Land and the land of the sd. Robert Jeffries 500 pches to the place of Beginning containing six hundred acres & the allowance of Six acres plent-

on the 15th of May 1715 by James Steel order of the 8th of the same month
bld. Woodward having sold his Right to Hattie German The Proprietaries
ordered this to be returned to Hattie German in pursuance of their
Warrant dated the 14th day of January 1734.

Returned into the Secretary's office the 15th day of February 1734.
