Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 3d. day of the 6ms. 1793 for Chas. Willing in pursuance of his warrant dated the 21st. day of April 1792 adjoining Chas. Willing No. 1183 and adjoining lands surveyed for the Episcopal accadamy on the west of and adjoining the old district line between McClay & Edmiston and including a part of Williamson's road containing one thousand and ninety nine and a half acres and allowance of six pcent.
