



The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land called Dilworth entered in John Hoge's Survey book and dated December 3d. 1794 made in pursuance of a warrant granted to Charles Beverington Dated September 9th. 1793 Situate on the waters of little Beaver Creek in Beaver County, containing 425 acres & 64 perches with 6 per cent allowance &c.

August 10th. 1801.
