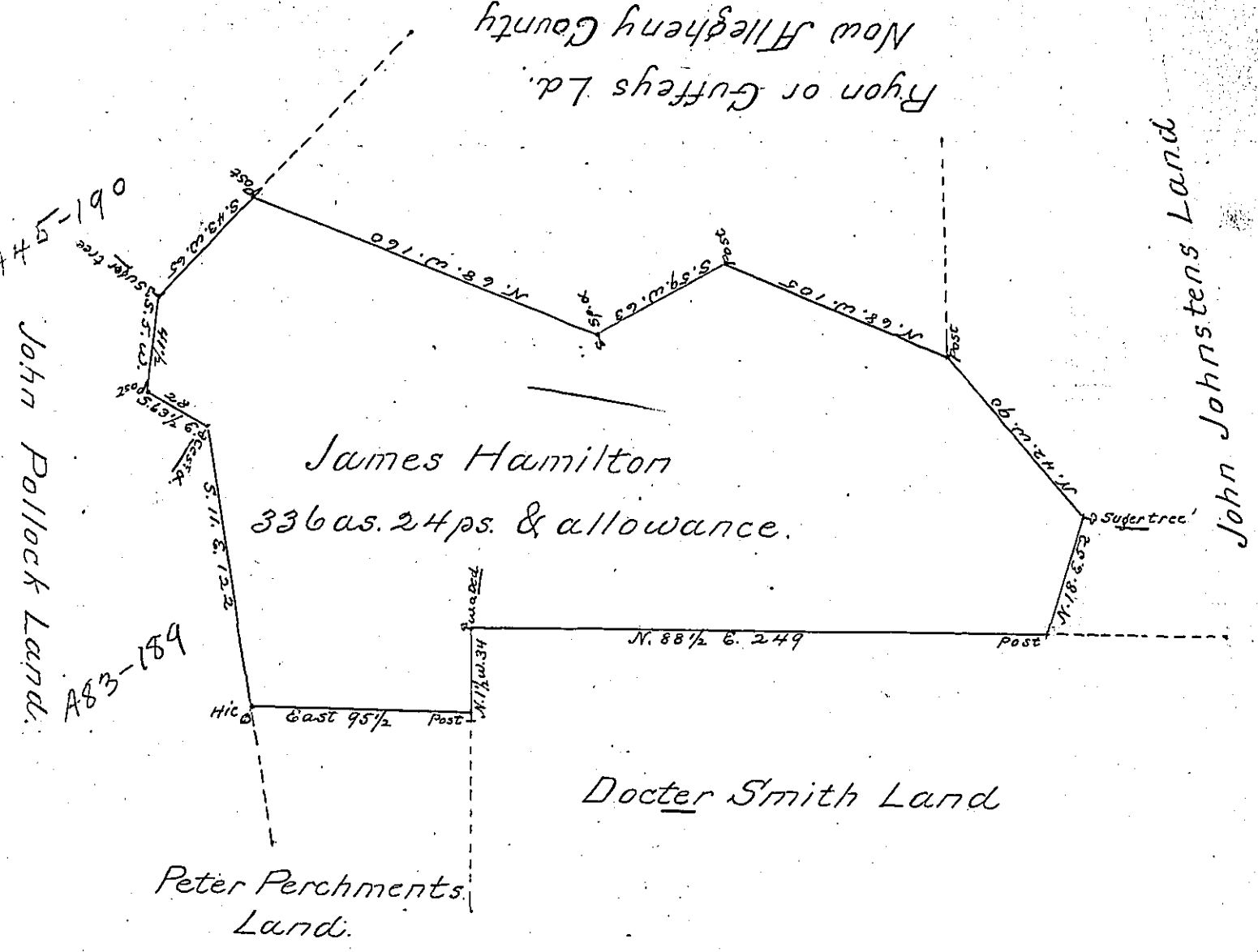


Note The warrant was granted to Archibald Hamilton

In pursuance of (661) warrant dated 26<sup>th</sup> May 3d. 1785 (661) there was Surveyd <sup>Archibald</sup> for James Hamilton the above described Tract of Land containing Three hundred and thirty Six acres and twenty four Patches with an allowance proportioned to Six per cent. for Roads &c. adjoining Land of John Johnstons and others in Pitt Township Westmoreland County Surveyd September 10th. 1785.
