To the Principle Surveyor of any County within the Commonwealth of Virginia This shall be your Warrant to survey and lay off in one or more Surveys for John Swain his Heirs or Assigns the Quantity of Four Hundred acres due unto the said John Swain on preemption in pursuance of a Certificate granted him by the Commissioners of Yhoganian, Monongahala & Ohio which Certificate is recd. into the Ld. office in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty pounds current money paid into the publick Treasury the payment whereof to the Treasury hath been duly certify'd by the Auditors of Publick accounts and their Certificate received into the Land office. Given under my hand and the seal of said office this twenty seventh day of June in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty.
