



The above is the Draught of a Tract of Land called Walnut-Bank, Situate on the Waters of the Chest Creek, about Half a mile below the old Trading-Path; adjoining Lands of Alexander Stewart, Chas Gough, John Kelsoe, and Alexander Murray in Cumberland County containing Four Hundred and Twelve acres, one Hundred and thirty eight perches and the usual allowance of Six p cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 30th Day of June 1769 for Alexander Barclay Esqr. In pursuance of an order No. 1898 dated the 3d. Day of April
