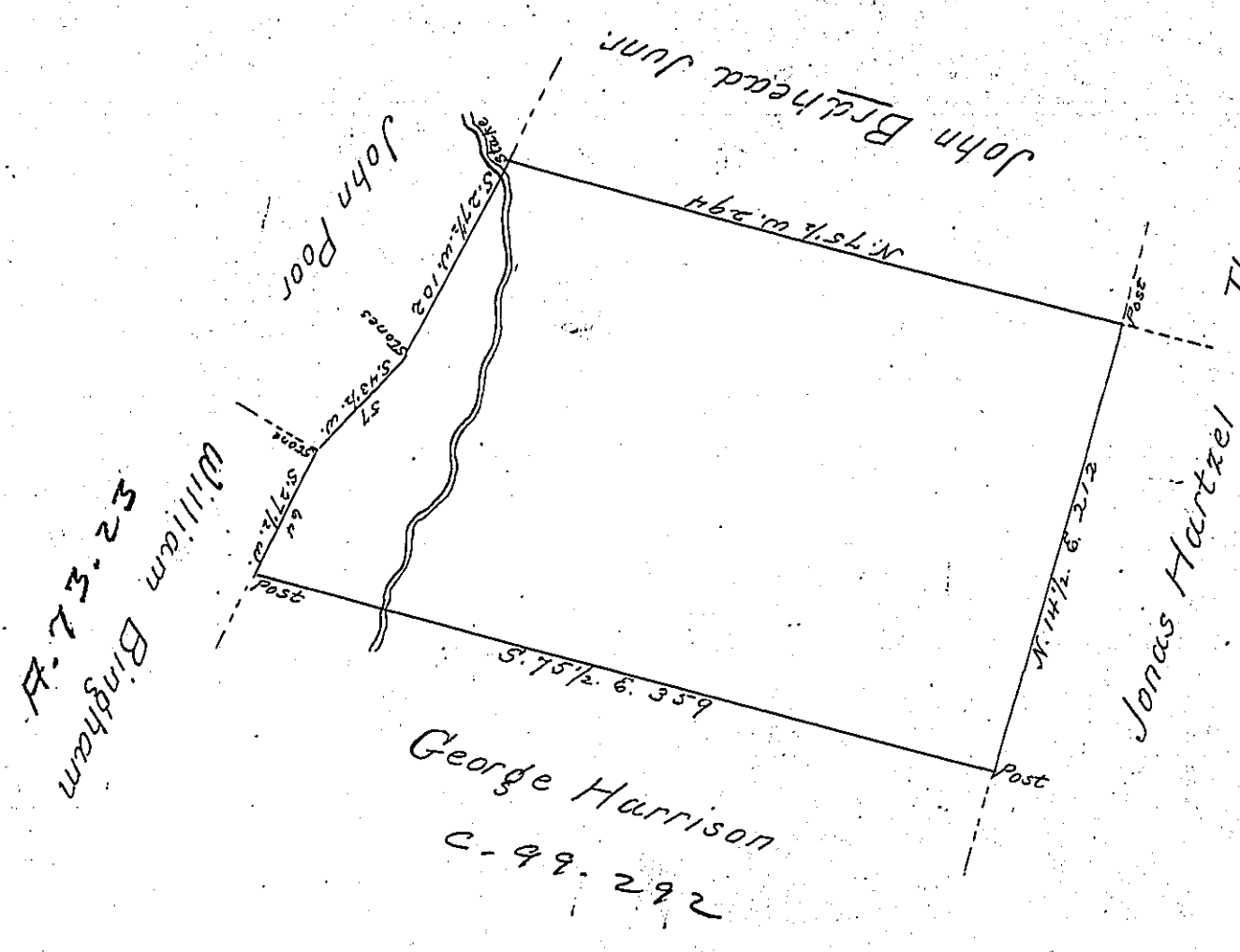

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day  
of July 1793 and order of survey recd. May 9<sup>th</sup> 1846  
Surveyed May 26<sup>th</sup> 1846 to Ann Bingham the above  
described Tract of Land situate in Dingman & Del-  
aware Townships (formerly Northampton) now Pike  
County containing four hundred and six acres  
one hundred and twenty six perches and allow-  
ance of Six p<sup>l</sup>ch. for roads &c.
