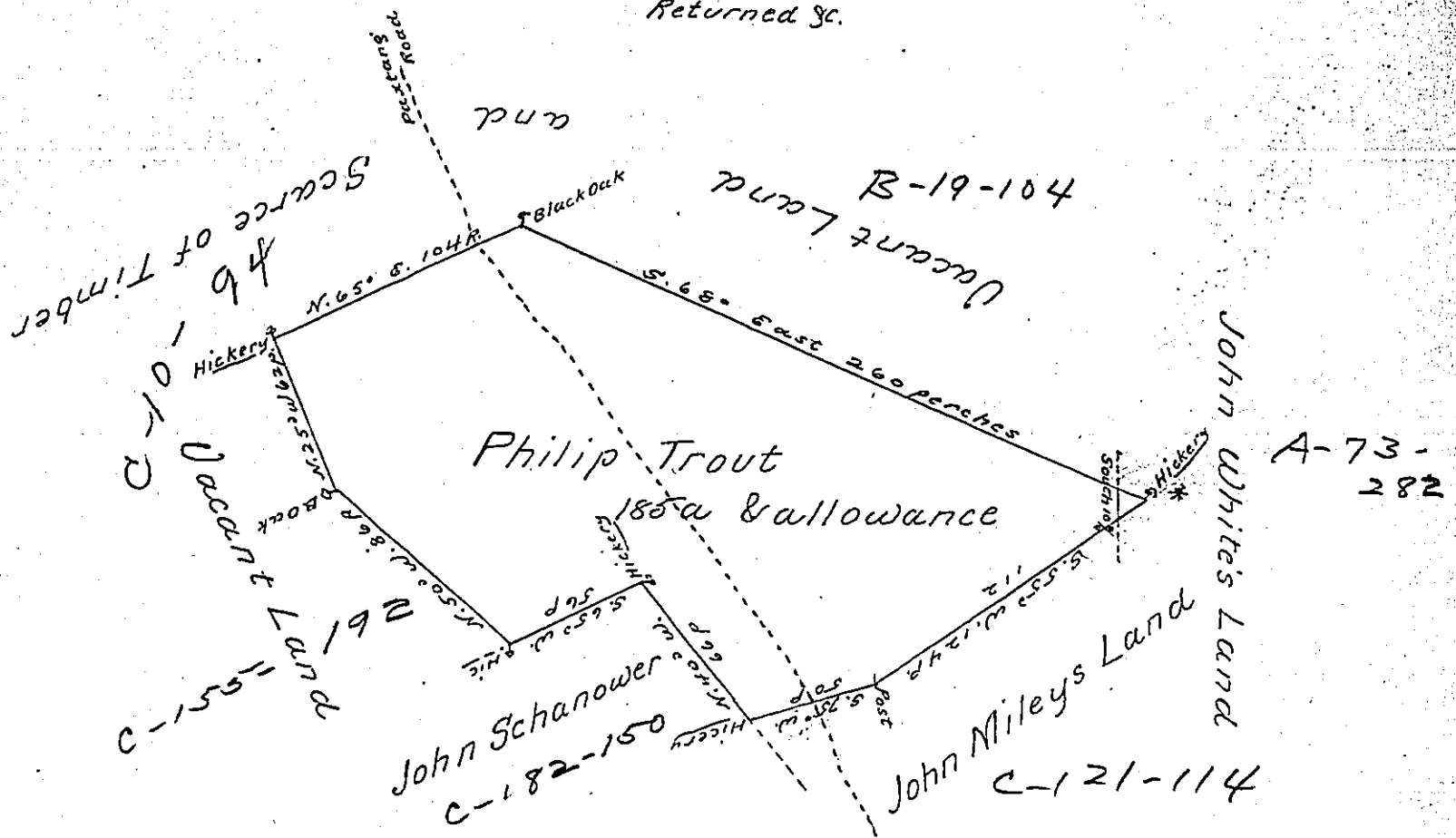

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the second day of November Anno Dom. 1736 The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Philip Trout in the Township of Collicie in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a post thence south 75 degrees west by the Land of John Miley 50 perches to a Hickery &c. containing One Hundred & Eighty five acres beside allowance of Six pcent.
