



Situate on the Ridge between Dunbars Run and the Irish Run including the Sugar Camp in Dunbar, formerly a part of Franklin township Fayette County & Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant in the name of said Higginson for 150 acres of land dated the 21st day of February 1794

I find the above to be correct and properly located and am informed by Alex. M. Clean late D. J. Heat Morris Morris (from whose notes as it is taken) was duly authorized by him to make this and sundry other surveys for Isaac Meason in the summer of 1795, he thinks in the month of June
