In Pursuance of an Order from his Honor the Governor Dated February the Sixth Anno Domini 1766 There was Surveyed for Mr. William Trent a Certain Lot of Ground Situate Contiguous to the Town of Carlisle Eastward of the said Town. Containing in Length East and West Two Hundred and Seventy Seven feet and in Breadth North and South Sixty feet. Bounded Southward by the Road Extending from the East end of High Street to Letort Spring & on the same range with said Street, Westward by East Street Northward by vacant Ground and Eastward by Letort Spring
