



The Above is a Draught of a Survey made the 9th Day of Feb^r 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Hoansall Dated the 25th Day of Oct^r 1784 Situate on a Branch of Fish Creek Called Big Brook in Washington County Containing four hundred acres with usual allowance for Roads -
