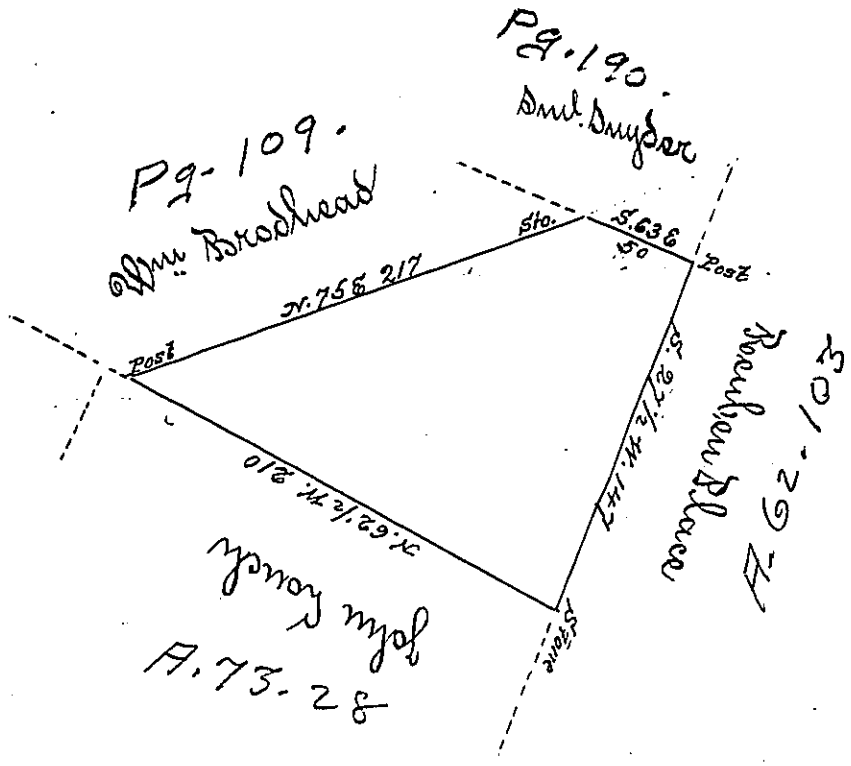


Porter -

By virtue of a warrant dated the 29th day of January 1793 surveyed the 19th day of February 1855 to Charles Berry the above described tract of land situate in (formerly Delaware) now Porter Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County - adjoining land granted to John Couch containing one hundred and twelve acres - sixty perches and the allowance of six p^r. C^t for Roads &c
