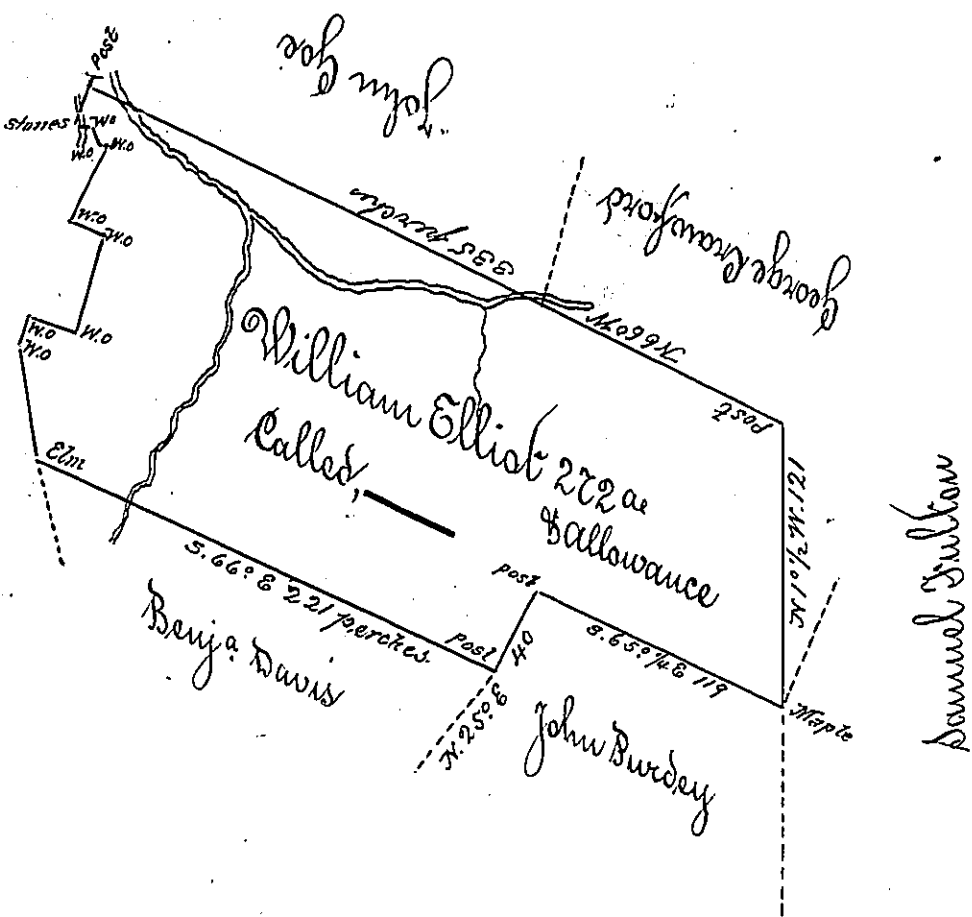


The courses down this side as follows—
