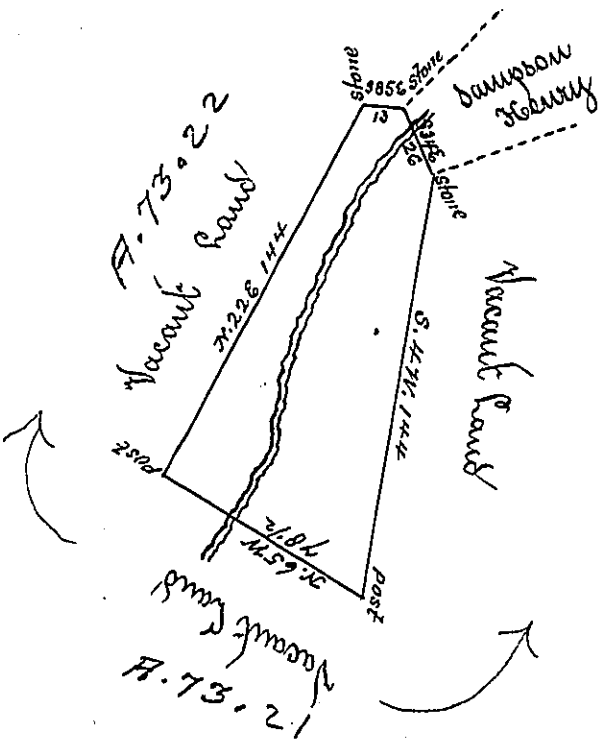

By virtue of a warrant dated 7<sup>th</sup> June 1841 surveyed 29<sup>th</sup> June 1841 to Cyril C. D. Dincho the above described tract of land situate on a branch of "Big Bushkill" called "Indian Cabin Branch" adjoining lands of surveyed to Dampson Henry and vacant land in Delaware Township Pike County containing fourty six acres and forty six perches and the allowance of six p<sup>er</sup> c<sup>t</sup> for roads &c.
