In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for William Cook on a Certain Lot of ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number thirty four Containing in Breadth East and west on the South side of Shamokin Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street, Eastward by Lot Number thirty five, Southward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number thirty three. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February 1775 for George Vaughan
