

Note the whole of the above Survey contains 54 3/4 Acs. Strict Measure 155 1/4 of which was surveyed on an old order in the name of Jos. Decker dated Apr<sup>r</sup> 3d 1760. No 3779. The Balance is 374 Acs Strict Measure.
