



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to the Heirs & Representatives of William Venables dec'd dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February 1752. for a City lot appurtenant to the purchase of 416  $\frac{1}{3}$  acres I did Survey & layout on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1761 a certain Lot or piece of Ground, situate on the West side of Fifth Street, between Walnut and Spruce Streets, containing in Breadth on 5<sup>th</sup> Street eighty two feet four inches, and in Length Westward one hundred and Ninety eight feet. Bounded Eastward by Fifth Street also Northward & Westward by Vacant Ground, & Southward by a lot formerly laid out to George Gleaves. And on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1773. I divided the same Lot into two equal parts the Northermost moiety or 41 feet 2 inches thereof is now in the possession of Jacob Van Reed of the City of Philadelphia, and the Southermost moiety or forty one feet two inches thereof is now in the possession of Willm Ashbridge. Return'd into the Secretaries Office the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1773. -
