Surveyed on the Twenty fourth Day of March 1733 No Christopher Hankabrant a Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philada Beginning at a post being a corner of Jacob Kellers Land thence by the same North one Hundred & Eighty four to a another corner post of ye sd Jacob Kellers land thence the same course by Vacant land forty two perches to a post thence by Vacant land Northeast Ninety four perches to a Hickory Sapl in a corner of Andrew Hawkes land thence by the same Southwest Two hundred and twenty six perches to a hickory thence by land of Berick Johnson Southeast Ninety four perches to ye place of Beginning Containing one hundred & Twenty Five Acres with usual Allowance.
