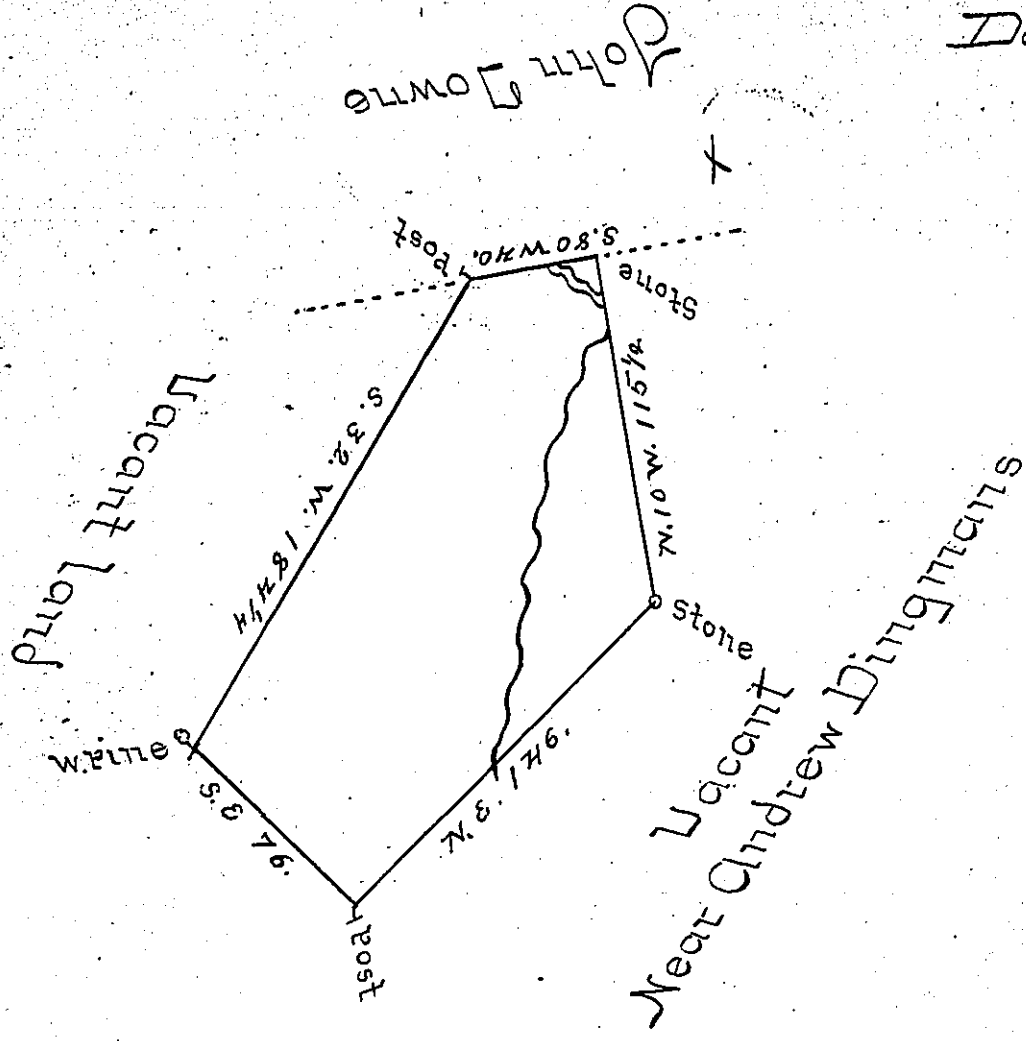


Delaware Tr.

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> January 1793 Surveyed the 16 May 1793 to Martin Ryerson Leonard Struble and Benjamin Hull the above described tract of land situate on a small branch of Dingman creek about six or seven miles from Delaware River in Delaware Township Northampton County containing One hundred and four Acres a quarter and the allowance of six Percent &c.
