The last mentioned line was run by Thomas Lightfoot long since Becks Survey was made. I endeavored to extend the lines into Paterson and Moores Surveys so as to give Beck his Complement of land, but was stopped by Paterson and Moore, who threatened if I offered to run a line into their surveyed land they would break My Compass
