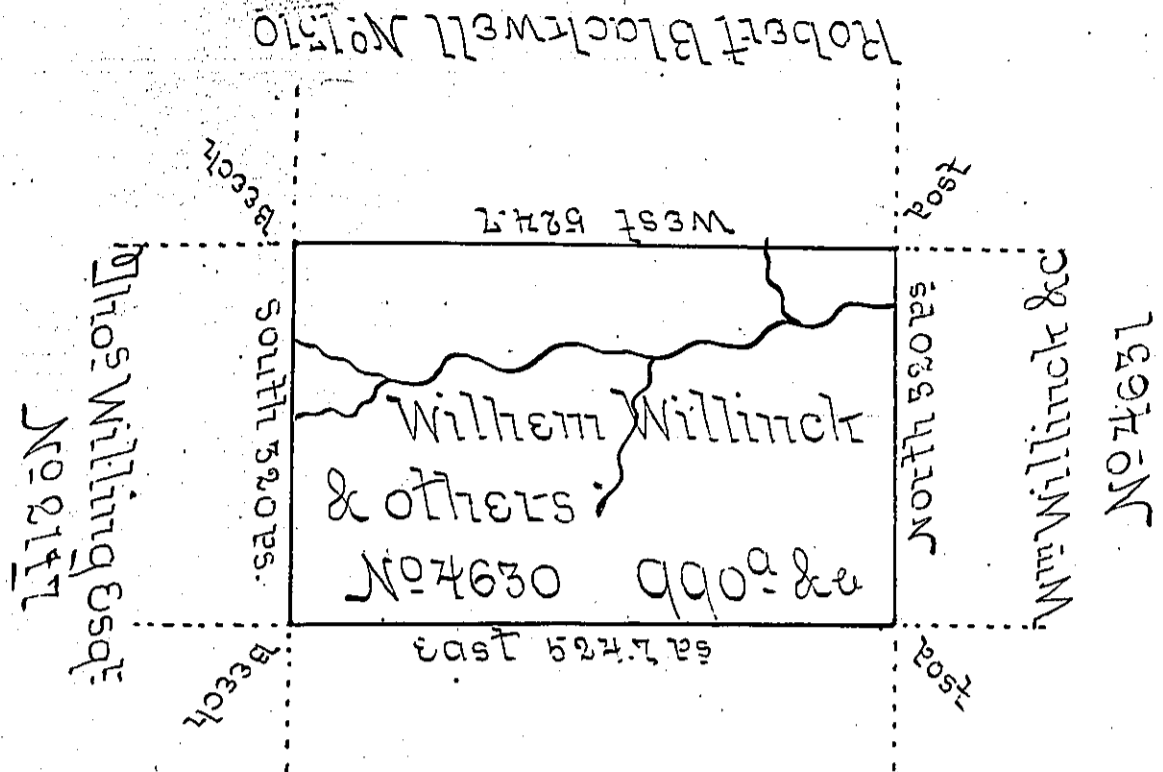

No 2 in the late purchase Northumberland County containing nine hundred and ninety acres & the Allowance of Six Percent for Roads &c.
