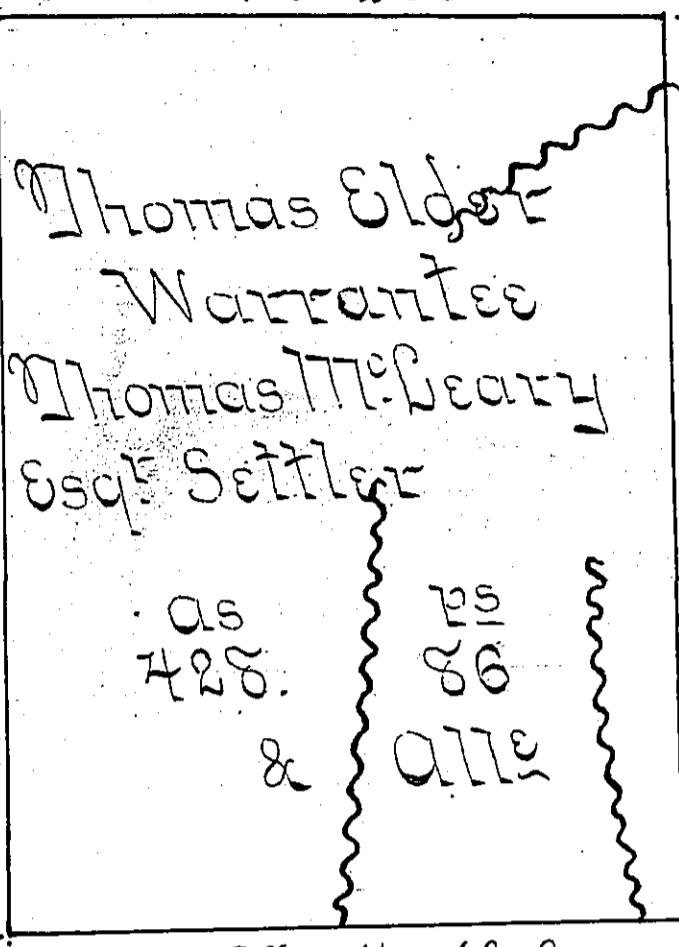

for 400 Acres of land. Dated Feb<sup>y</sup> the 3<sup>d</sup> 1794 being  
the same tract on which Thomas McBeary Esqr  
now lives and improves, and by agreement with the  
Warrantee Concurred in making the Survey.
