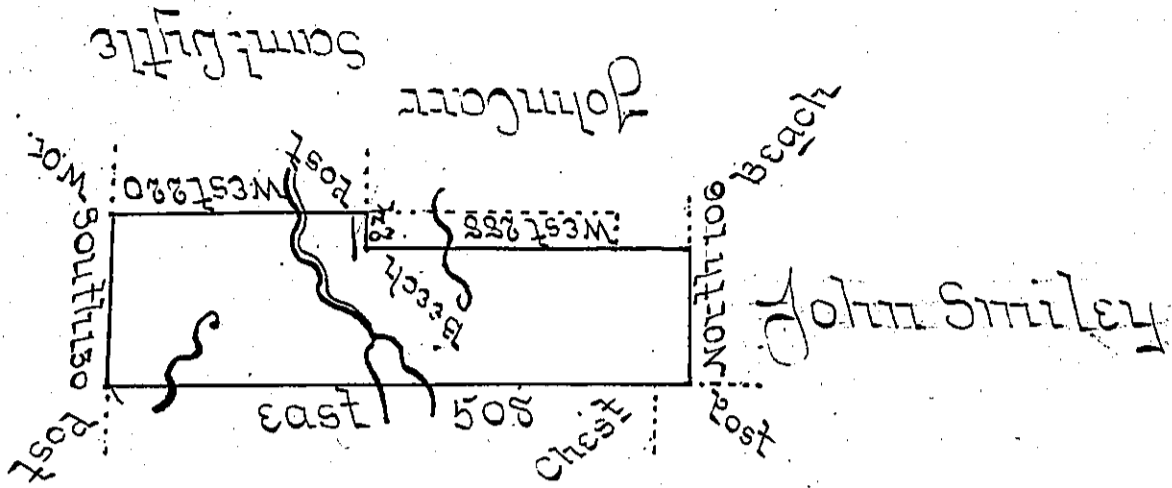


Holland Claims



Robt Forster

A Draught of a tract of land in Waterford Township Erie county on the Waters of French creek surveyed the 19th of August 1801 for Elisha Stodard by Virtue of his Actual Settlement and improvement, and resurveyed (on a Warrant dated the 18th of November 1801 granted to George Eliot) on the 8th day of November 1802 Containing 348 Acres an half & Allowance &c

MS Joseph Clark claims by virtue of George Eliot's warrant, as far North as the dotted line in the draught, but John Carr and Elisha Stodard having agreed to the black lines on the 19th of Augt 1801 as run at that time on the ground, John Carr will not suffer the lines to be altered -
