



A Draught of a Tract of land situated in Laebocuss Township Erie County on the Waters of French Creek surveyed May 3^d 1831 for Joseph Clark by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date March 25th 1831 and containing 405 acres and 30 perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Wilson King U.S. I do hereby Officially certify and make known that from the books or documents in my Office the above land does not appear to have been appropriated to any Person other than said applicant except that there is a Survey of the same noted in the Survey Book kept by my predecessor John Cochran Esq^r as made on the 30th Day of July 1801 for Robert Foster in pursuance of his actual Settlement Residence and improvement. But I believe there is now no claim other than that of the said Joseph Clark upon the land.
