



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Deer Lick situate in Woodcock Valley on the west side of the Warriors Ridge adjoining Land of Dr. William Smith & James Robb in Barre Township in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & forty nine acres & the usual allowance of six pcent for Roads &c. Re-Surveyed the 9th Day of September 1775 agreeable to old lines formerly run by Mr. Tea & to rectify a mistake in the former survey which was made for William Alexander in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 10th Day of September 1762 by
