



A Draught of John Whitsit's Land situate on a Branch of Swahatawro Creek near Quitapohills in the Township of Lebanon in the County of Lancaster Containing one hundred & sixteen acres & an half & the allowance of 6 ^{Ac.} on the Hundred for roads &c. By Virtue of the Proprietaries Warrt dated the 31st day of October 1738 Survey'd the 24th of October 1741.

To Tho. Cookson

Sir. The above is returned upon a Warrt directed to Saml. Blunston which among several others at his request I executed - Next Monday I propose to set off for y^e other side Susquehanna where I shall spend 3 or 4 weeks amongst 'em & endeavor to serve y^e Prop^{ies} in a Commodious Tract & also the Cent^y formerly mentioned
