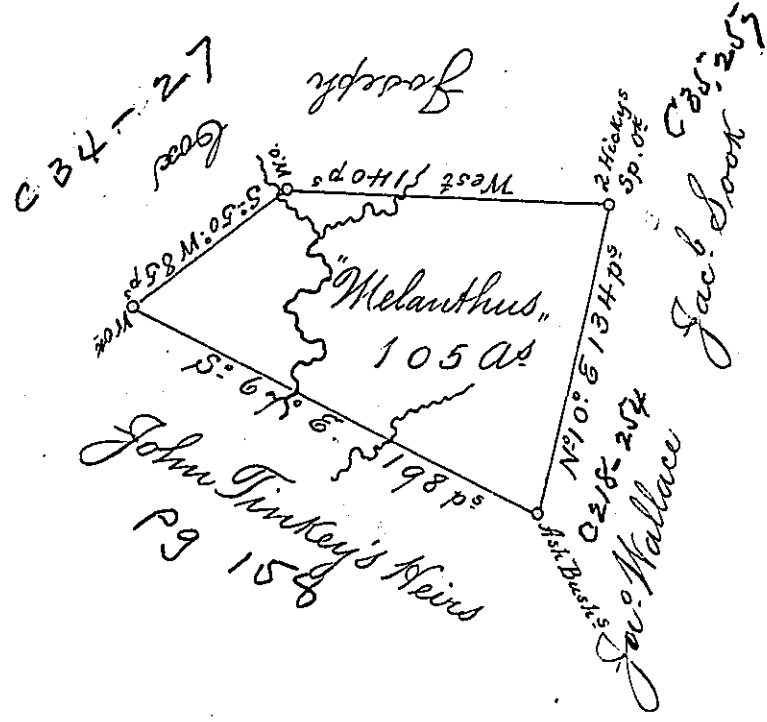


Returned February 9th 1789
