



Survey'd to Jacob Anthony on the 2^d Day of February 1775. The above Described Tract of Three hundred & twenty Acres & an half of an Acre & allowrance of Six p. Ct Situate Including a White Oak marked *FA* near to a Gum marked with 12 Notches both standing in a fork of a Branch of Plumb Creek which Empties into the West side of said Plumb Creek about two or three Miles above the Kittanning Path & to extend Northward from said marked Trees in Westmoreland County. By Warrant of the 4th Day of January 1775
