



The above is a draught of a survey made the 24th of October 1786 in pursuance of a Warrant granted the ninth day of Sept^r 1786 to Alexander Addison It contains 408 acres & 128 perches with the usual allowance of 5 Cent: is called Peter's Camp and is situated on the South Branch of Ten Mile Creek in Washington County
