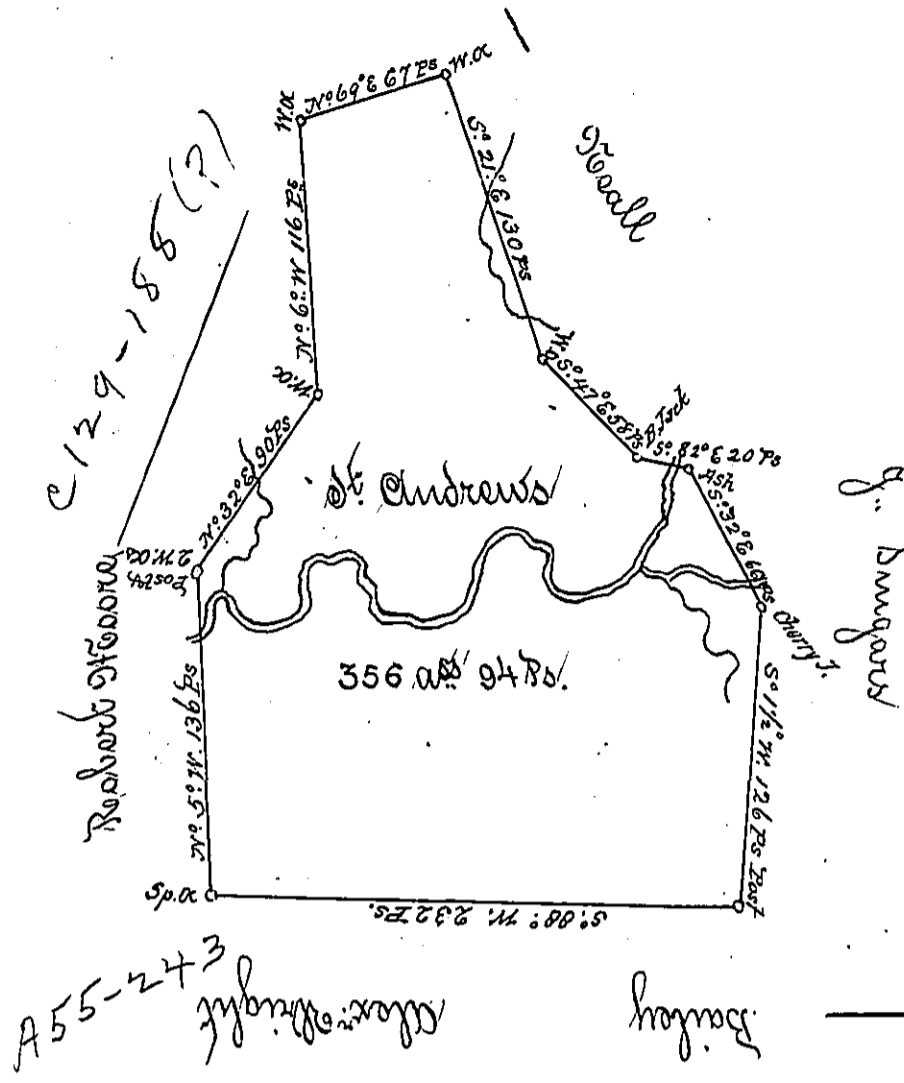

A Draught of a survey called "St. Andrews" situate on the waters of Roason Cr. in Washington County, containing 356 ac. 94 Rs. strict Measure, executed Sept. 24th 1785 in consequence of a Certif. for 400 ac. granted to Hoases Andrews by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virg. to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties Accom^g. York^a and Ohio and duly entered with the County Surv. & C. Ent^d 23rd June 1780.

Note. In the list of Entries transmitted to us is Jo^s Andrews but there being no person of that name in that neighbourhood, and Hoases Andrews having a Certif. duly endorsed we conclude it a mistake in y^e copying.
