



The Draught of a tract of land situate in Potter Township Centre County containing two hundred and thirty Acres, twenty four perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 11th day of November 1815 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Hoopes dated the 11th day of July 1815.

The improvements on the above described tract of land consists of a dwelling house and barn, about thirty Acres of cleared land, and the said Thomas Hoopes and family now actually residing on the same - and by information was first improved in the year 1798.
