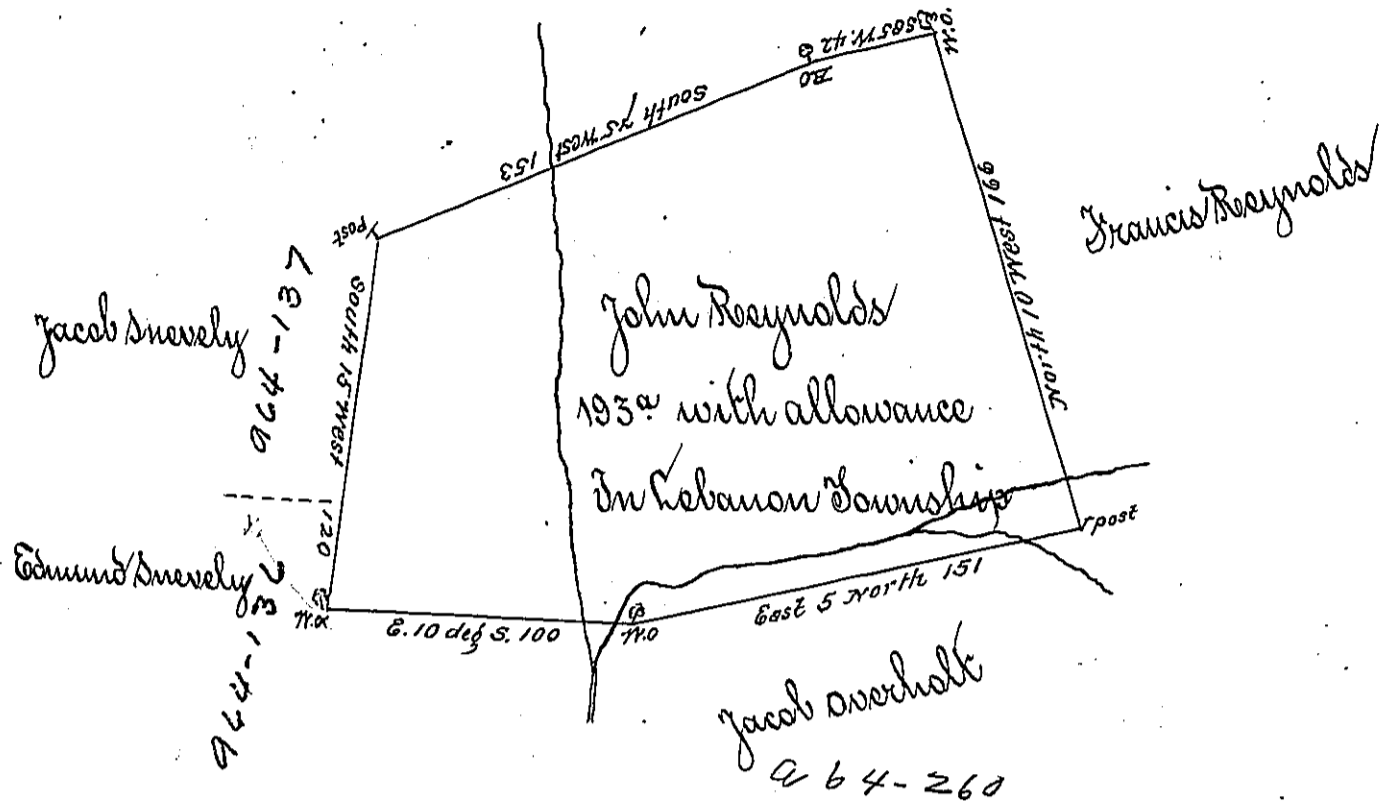

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Bearing Date the 10th Day of October Anno Dom: 1738 Surveyed the 5th Day of March 1739 to John Reynolds a Tract of Land in the Township of Lebanon in Lancaster County Beginning at a White Oak in the Line of Edmund Smerelys Land thence East 10 deg South 100 perches to a white Oak thence East 5 deg North 151 perches to a post thence north 10 deg West 166 per to a white Oak thence South 85 deg West 42 per. to a Black Oak thence South 25 West 153 per. to a post thence South 15 deg West 120 per. to a white Oak the place of Beginning Containing One Hundred & ninety three acres with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c
