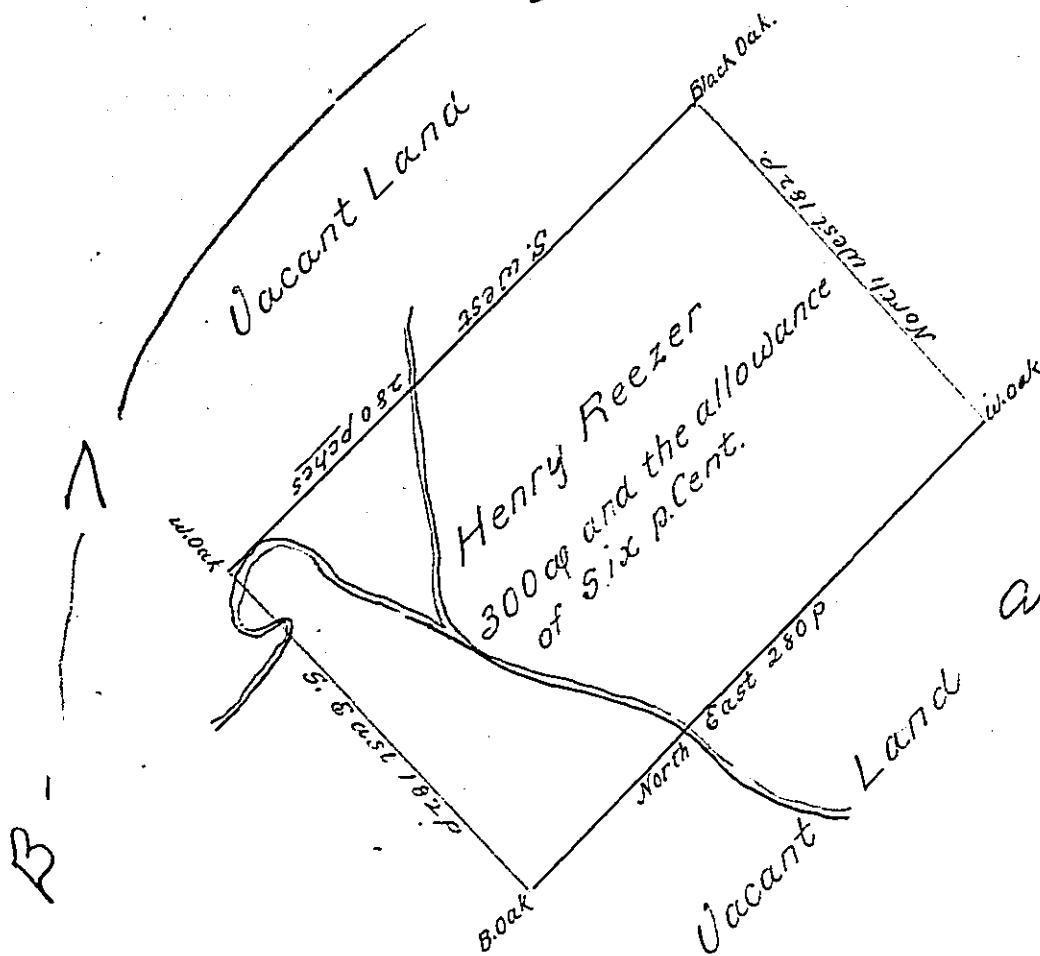

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 24th day of January 1733 Survey'd to Henry Reezer the 30th of the same month A Tract of Land situate on a small Branch of Schookill in Lancaster County, Beginning at a white oak on the North west side of the sd. Branch thence south east by Vacant Land 182 pches to a Black Oak thence north east by Vacant Land 280 pches to a white oak thence North west by vacant Land 182 pches to a Black oak thence South west by vacant land 280 pches to the Beginning containing three Hundred acres and the allowance of Six p. Cent.
