



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 18th. Day of April Anno Dom. 1738 The above described Tract of Land was Survey'd unto Christian (or Christopher) Griffith in Salisbury Township in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a post in the line of William Jones thence West South West along the same 40 perches to a Chestnut thence South 24 degrees east by Thomas Faulkner 110 perches to a post thence east north east by the same & the land of Aron Jenkin 40 perches to a Chestnut tree thence North 24 Deg. west by John Hasting 110 perches to the place of Beginning containing Twenty Six acres Beside ye usual allowance 16th of 4 mo. 1738.
