



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarys Bearing date the seventeenth day of May Anno Domini 1739 Surveyd to Tybald Poff (called by mistake in the warrant David Poff) a Tract of Land in the Township of Gabon & County of Lancaster Beginning at a post corner of Hans Adam Sniders Land thence by the same North 36 deg west 66 perches to a maple thence North 68 deg west 28 per to a hick thence North 44 deg East 46 per to a white oak thence North by East 175 per to a post thence by the Land of John Kingrie South West by South 143 per & 1/2 to a post thence North 56 deg west 51 per to a hickory thence South west by South ^{by Benja Knolt Settlement} 100 per to a hickory thence South 43 deg east ^{by Joseph Scrotzer's Settlement} 174 per to a white oak thence North 60 deg ^{by vacant land} 1/2 each 66 perches to the place of Beginning containing one Hundred Thirty five acres & the allowance of six p cent for Roads &c.
