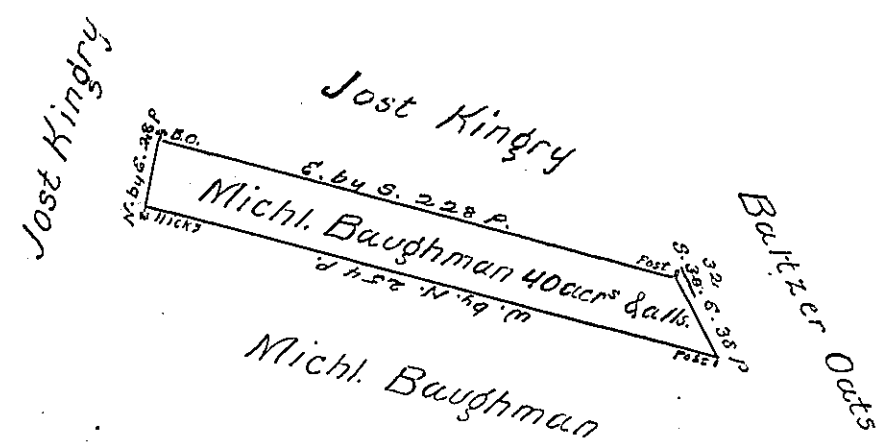

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Honble Proprietaries bearing date the Tenth --- day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty (forty one) There was Survey'd & laid out unto Michael Baughman therein named a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Lebanon in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Hickory Tree in the line of other Lands of the sd. Michael Baughman thence North by East by the Land of Jost Kingry twenty eight perches to a Black Oak thence East by South by ye Land of the sd. Jost Kingry two hundred & twenty eight perches to a post thence south thirty two degrees east thirty eight perches by Baltzer Oats's Land to a post thence west by North by ye sd. Michl. Baughmans Land two hundred & fifty four perches to ye place of Beginning Containing forty acres & the usual allowance for Roads &c.
