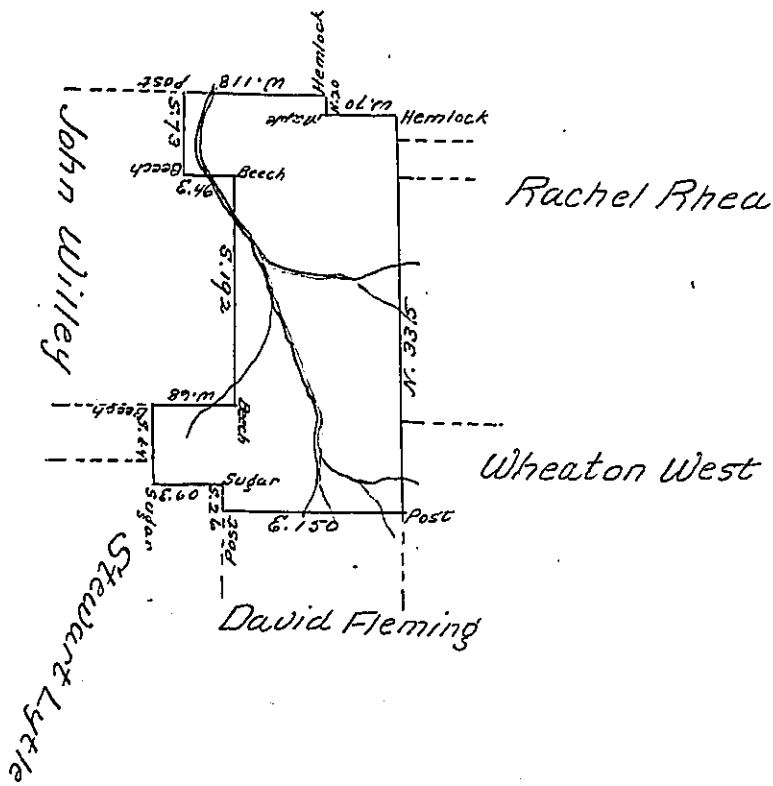


Moravian Grant



A draught of a tract of land situate in Waterford township Erie County on the East side of French Creek on the waters of said Creek, Surveyed the 18 of August 1801 for James Carr Senr. by virtue of his actual settlement residence & improvement containing 337 acres and thirty two perches and allowance &c.

Thereby certify that the foregoing draught, field notes & entry are true and correct copies from the survey book kept by John Cochran Esq. former Deputy Surveyor of Erie County.
