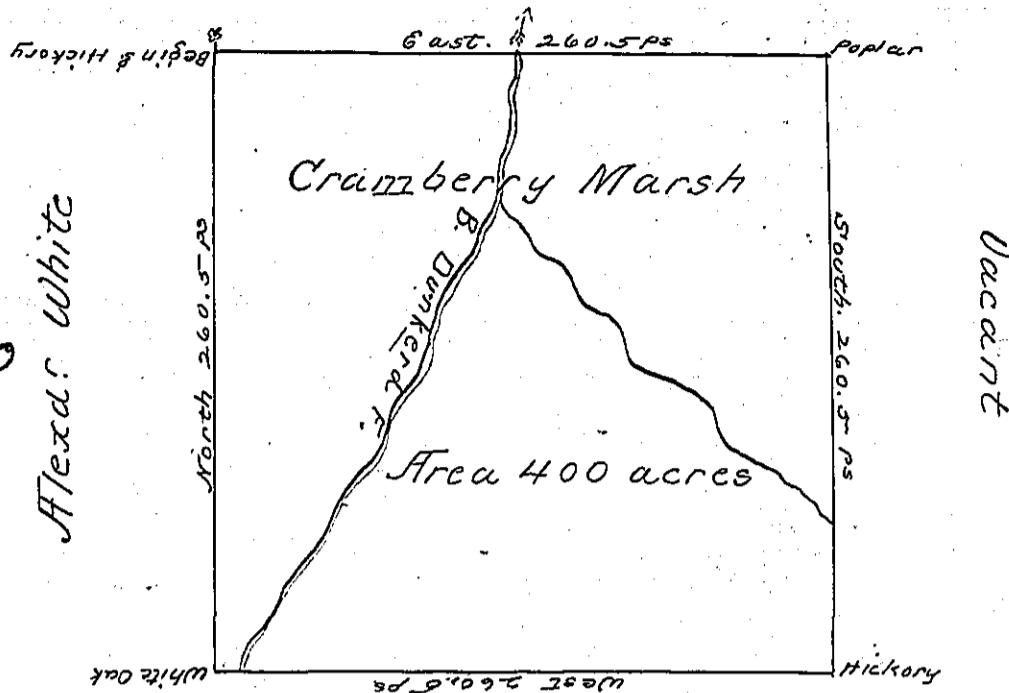

Called (Cranberry Marsh) containing four hundred acres with allowe. of 6 percent for Roads.
