I do hereby certify that I appointed Henry Taylor to survey the above described tract of land, containing three hundred & two acres, two quarters & eighteen perches, on the west side the Monongahela river in the forks of Chartiers Creek, which was executed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1771, Now Strasburg To<sup>o</sup> Washington Co<sup>y</sup>.
